MEDICAL DIRECTOR, Anchorage Neighborhood Health Center

The Medical Director is a senior level administrative position with responsibility for all clinical services at all ANHC sites. This responsibility includes the authority to oversee all aspects of health care delivery including planning, resource allocation, growth and development, regulatory compliance, quality, efficiency and the supervision of all medical staff. The Medical Director will supervise other medical staff, assisting the Executive Director with the authority to assign and delegate responsibilities as necessary. This is a full time position with a flexible balance of clinical and administrative duties targeting an approximate time ratio of 70% administrative and 30% clinical. Clinical duties include inpatient and outpatient services as a primary care physician including on-call responsibilities where appropriate. The Medical Director is directly accountable to the ANHC Executive Director with collateral accountability to the Board of Directors.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Board Certification in Family Medicine, Pediatrics, or Internal Medicine
- Licensed or license eligible by the State of Alaska
- Must maintain an unrestricted license to practice in Alaska and maintain active privileges at the hospital
- Proven ability in clinical practice
- Excellent writing and speaking communication skills
- A high energy level and the ability to follow projects through to completion
- Ability to build consensus and work in a team setting
- Strong conflict management, negotiation and persuasion skills, professional demeanor, attitude, and motivation is essential
